


Self Service Step-By-Step Procedures for Pension Plan Election 2023

Purpose: The purpose of this document is to provide a visual guide for eligible employees to confirm or make changes to their current pension plan elections.

- Log into the portal via <https://eim.login.us2.oraclecloud.com/> → Click on Company Single Sign-On button →

Note: For **Company Single Sign-On**, you must use office-365/outlook credentials, i.e., your City of Memphis email address and password. This option is available **only** for full-time and part-time employees.

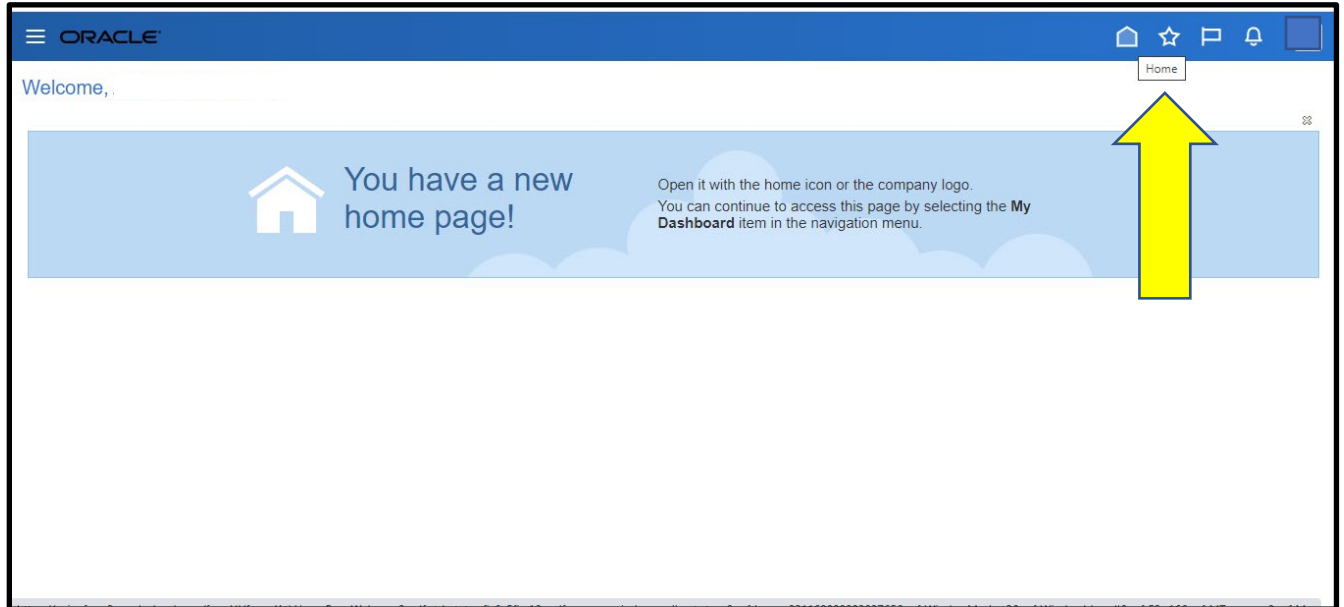

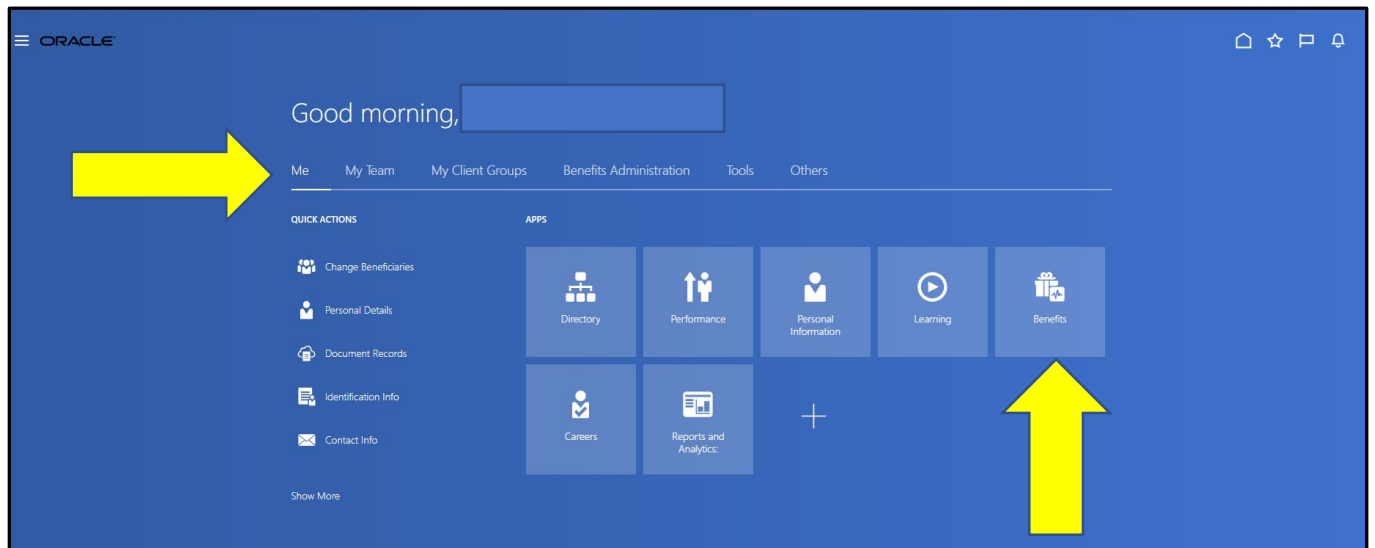

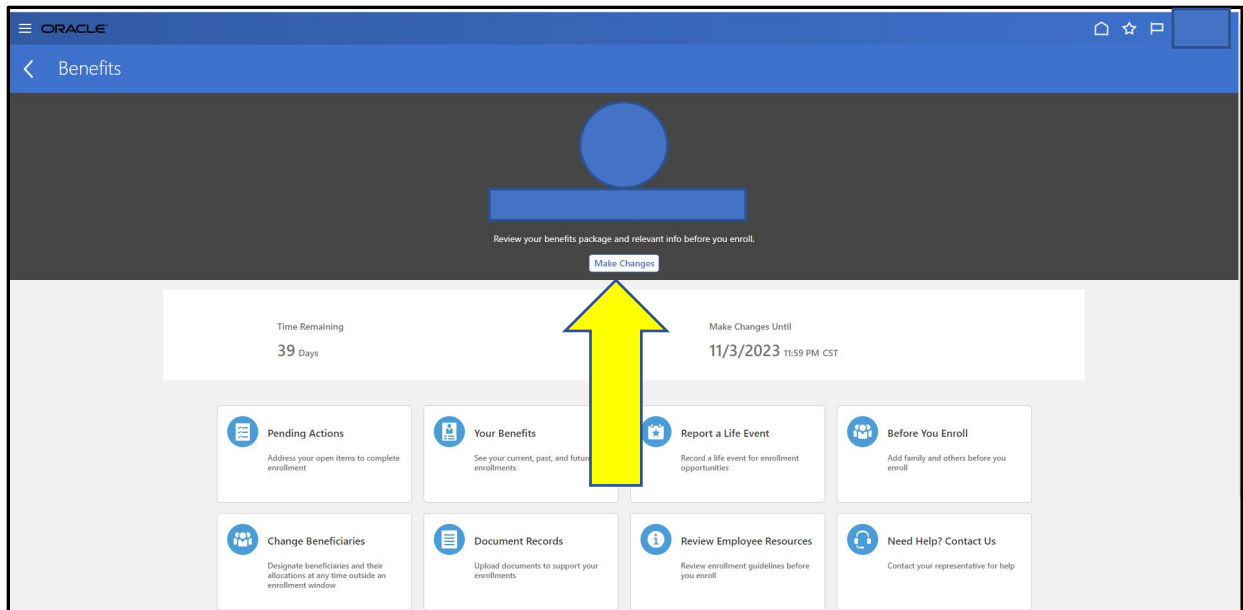


➤ You will see the screen below → Go to the **"Me"** tab → Click on the **"Benefits"** button →

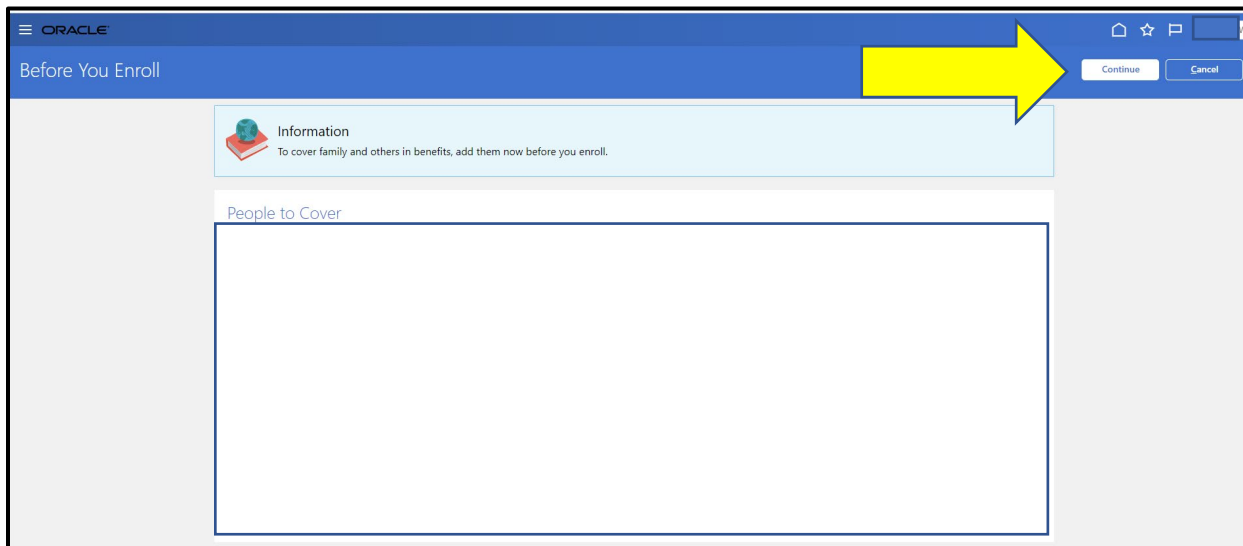

➤ Click on the **“Continue”** button →

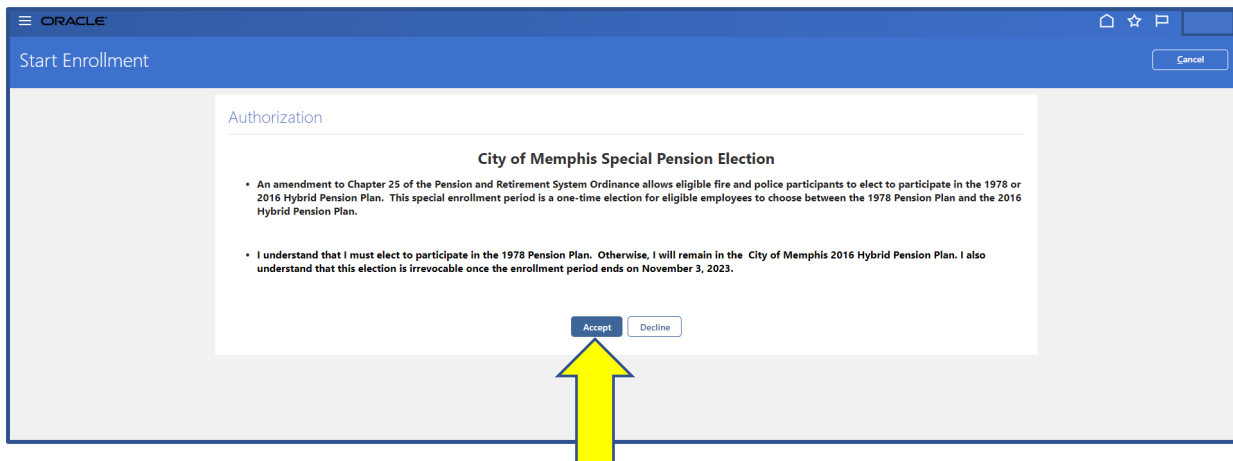

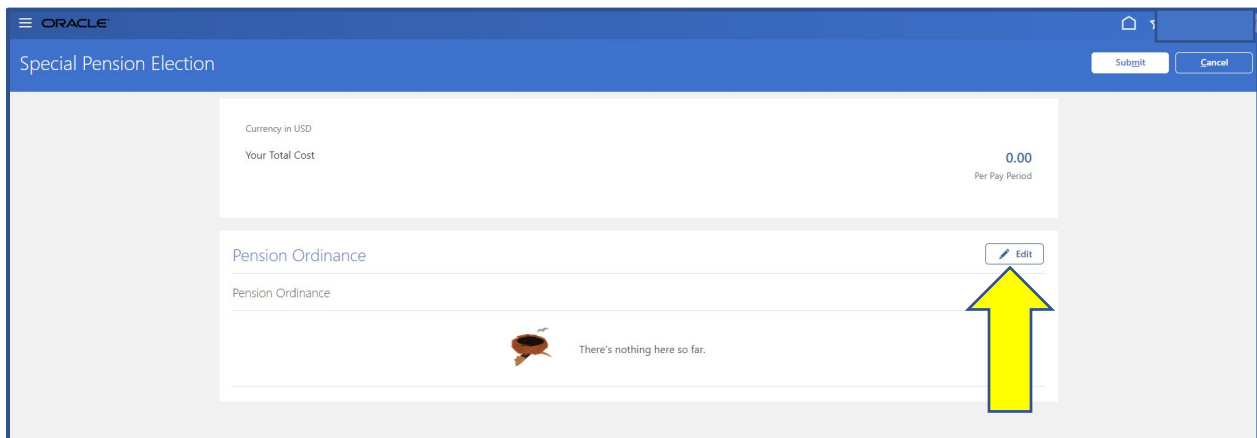

City of Memphis Special Pension Election

- An amendment to Chapter 25 of the Pension and Retirement System Ordinance allows eligible fire and police participants to elect to participate in the 1978 or 2016 Hybrid Pension Plan. This special enrollment period is a one-time election for eligible employees to choose between the 1978 Pension Plan and the 2016 Hybrid Pension Plan.
- I understand that I must elect to participate in the 1978 Pension Plan. Otherwise, I will remain in the City of Memphis 2016 Hybrid Pension Plan. I also understand that this election is irrevocable once the enrollment period ends on November 3, 2023.
